4.5 Jacques – General Manager (See report):

Christmas went well. Only problems with Electricity tripping. Possibly installing gas geysers. Do a gas course & do installation himself (Blue gas), will do homework. MA it'll be useful. JL overloaded plugs, but geysers are separate so doesn't affect the geysers (it takes an hour to refill warm). Don't know the cost, but look into the coils, instantly heats.

<u>Social Membership</u>: Is going to be a problem, from going from social to a Full / Family member to avoid joining fees. Social R450 vs Full R1500. Social member has no overnight or voting rights or use club storage. GE said they must still pay full membership, to up membership categories, not allowed in camping areas. JL to say No buses, etc. signage. GE to have access controlled by all the members gate. Public members hours are sunrise to sunset.

GE Social members should have social access cards & leaving should be monitored, as Water Affairs wants us to open to the locals. AH how do you control access & no overnight, but they're having a meal? DM - R450 is the fee, but no showering, just have to get the price right. To become a full member from social you have to then pay the entrance fee. Have access to club, toilet & bar. DM any conversion, have to go through the whole application. When they want to convert, we still have to have a joining fee, as they'll have right to vote & responsibility. We just have to monitor it.

AH we have a process, all part of introductory & they fully understand the do's & don't and have it all refined in contract & have a booklet given when joining. However public members need to be verbally told when they come in & signed at the gate. Let's monitor & see how it works, or cap it off.

<u>Retired campers:</u> What is the maximum stay? They usually come for 6 weeks. Not members, but long week stay. GE a 3 week stay, a standard fee, after that pay per week. Other clubs make it a 3 month cap. Board agreed 3 months. JD said other clubs charge R1500 per month for 2 people on public side. Board agreed. A proven retired member. DM to consider what facilities to have open, but JD said no they don't do anything.

<u>Honorary Members:</u> It is open-ended. JL we need to give an end date. GE said there should be the original owner that is paying, when they stop paying or upon death it reverts back to the club.

Pump lifted & added 10 m of electric cable with stickers warning danger.

Shane supplied 8 cameras. Quote from local guy, will recorder, cable, use JD monitor linked to remote monitor (link to phone). MA requesting by the caravan park & at the end.
